

**FSU Professor Edward Stringham appears on  
Fox & Friends, the Blaze TV, the Rick Amato Show, and is

Fayetteville, North Carolina, July 2, 2014 – This month Fayetteville State University professor Edward Stringham appeared on quite a few shows including the morning Fox News show Fox & Friends. The professor of economics and entrepreneurship talked about current and important issues affecting the U.S. economy – the signs our economy is not recovering including a record high number of men not in the labor force. “When someone cannot find a job and leaves the labor force. The professor recommends government reconsider many of the policies that make hiring more expensive or difficult including minimum wage, mandated healthcare, and other anti-business policies.

On the Blaze TV Stringham talked about government’s proposed retirement accounts that proponents claim will have guaranteed rate of return. Stringham argued, “If something sounds too good to be true, it probably is.” On the Rick Amato Show Stringham discussed policies that could help get Americans back to work. Finally, Professor Stringham was named “One of the Hottest Libertarian Men Alive” by the popular website Liberty Viral. Stringham stated, “All I can say is I am flattered.”
